The City's current fire station located at 5101 Jessamine will be demolished by the end of 2009. In the meantime the City's Fire and EMS operations have been temporarily relocated on S. Rice in part of the Chevron Facility.

A new station will be built in the same location. In 2005 the City's voters voted to build a new fire station. Estimated costs for the new fire station is \$5million.. It is estimated that the new station will take approximately one year to build.



*"After 54 years of service the Bellaire Fire Station will be demolished to make way for a new station, slated for completion in late 2010. This new station has been designed to hold the necessary vehicles and equipment currently in place, and of sufficient size to house apparatus of the future, including a ladder truck. Each bedroom and restroom facility is individualized to optimize privacy. The living space is housed on the second floor, necessary to enlarge the apparatus floor. The first floor will house, along with the apparatus, the Fire Department offices and the Emergency Operations*

*Center. The EOC will also double as the Fire Department training venue and can be used for community gathering and outreach. 54 years is a long time for any fire station to last; we hope and plan for this new station to be just as reliable." Fire Chief Darryl Anderson.*
