Chapter 15, Section 1:

**Definition:** *A "Garage Sale" is the offering for sale of twenty (20) or more items of used personal property from a residence and shall include "patio sales, porch sales and driveway sales."*  
(Ordinance No. 1767, Sec. 1, 5-3-71)

Chapter 15, Section 2:

**Signs:** *The holder of a permit for a garage sale is hereby allowed to post only one sign, not larger than twenty-two inches by twenty-eight inches (22" x 28"), on the property where the sale is being held, announcing the sale.*  
(Ordinance No. 1767, Sec. 4, 5-3-71)

Chapter 15, Section 4:

**Duration and Frequency:** *No garage sale shall be held at any single location for a period of more than three (3) successive days, nor more often than twice in any calendar year.*  
(Ordinance No. 1767, Sec 2, 5-3-71)

## Required When Applying for a Garage or Estate Sale Permit

1. Identification that lists or confirms you as a Bellaire resident or in the case of an Estate Sale Administrator, legal identification and a copy of your contract to hold the sale or a document that confirms that you are acting on behalf of the property owner.
2. All garage sales are to be held at the address of the applicant. A neighbor will no longer be permitted to purchase a permit for someone who resides at a different address.
